FIELD DAYS

To clarify the sign-on and weigh-in procedures on a Field Day, an extract of the Rules 1, 2 and 11 are listed for your information:-

FIELD DAY RULES:

- Rule 1. Sign-on is compulsory and must be attended by all members and visitors, and pay the required FEE.
- Rule 2. At the discretion of the F.D.O. a member may make prior arrangements for a late sign-on.
- Rule 11. No member shall leave a venue before the stated weigh-in time, unless he notifies the F.D.O. or his assistant. The penalty for this offence shall be loss of all points for that Field Day, plus pay any cost that may be incurred in the ensuing search.

VEHICLES IN OFF-ROAD AREAS

The following is an extract from a recent notice in the West Australian newspaper regarding users of vehicles in off-road areas:-

NOTICE TO USERS OF VEHICLES
IN OFF-ROAD AREAS

Users of vehicles in any areas in which the provisions of the Control of Vehicles (Off-road areas) Act. 1985 apply, are reminded that as from Sunday, December 1, 1985, new provisions relating to seat belts and protective helmets, will come into force.

All motor vehicles, including those registered under the Road Traffic Act. 1974 will be required to have seat belts fitted and worn when used in off-road situations.

Modified penalties of \$40.00 will apply for failure to wear a seat belt or protective helmet.
