Dry Casting report 8 December 2013

Not much to report from the last drycasting with only 14 members casting on the day. Conditions were not all that bad with a south easterly blowing for most of the day.

The winner for the men's division on the day was Alan Hale, but attendance points for the General meeting meant the Rob Pekaar scored the highest points overall for the men.

The Club owns an air conditioned holiday house at Kalbarri which is available for rent to the public and club members at competitive rates. Link is above.

Peter Pekaar had the two longest casts for the day, 164 metres and 166 metres in the 112 gram. Alan Hale had 118 points in the double handed accuracy. Peter Pekaar had a bullseye in the single handed accuracy.

George Holman was the winner in the veterans. Terry Fuller and George Holman both had 141 points in the double handed accuracy.

The two longest casts for the day in the veterans were Ron Thomas 138 metres and George Holman 137 metres. And last but not least the State Estuary Veterans Champion managed 2 bullseyes, one in the double handed accuracy and one in the single handed accuracy.

Recently joined new member Klaus Schönwolf won the single handed accuracy with a good score of 31 points.

Terry Fuller used his computer drycasting scoring program to process the results to calculate the points, add all together, sort into final score order, extract the section winners and year's best, and the progressive scores for use at the end of the competition year.
