This month, Alan came down with braid line on one of his Alvey reels and showed us his prowess as a distance caster, leading the pack for quite some time. His ability is already sending shock waves through the Senior ranks. Keep it up, Alan.

Handling rigs after marking dry casting scores

Markers. Please do NOT throw the casting rigs off the court or to the side after marking. This often causes the rigs to roll and tangle and stops any swivel from working, especially with artificial bait rigs.

All that is required is to make sure the rig is not stuck in the ground or tangled and just place it flat on the ground for the caster to wind the rig back in.

Dry Casting results, 6 February 2011

These results have been prepared from the original hand written distances and scores recorded on the day. Marcia and Peter Pekaar copied the scores from the score sheets into an electronic format, adjusted the distance scores for the 20 metre measurement setback, and cross checked all final figures against the original score sheets.

Terry Fuller used his computer drycasting scoring program to process the results to calculate the points, add all together, sort into final score order, extract the section winners and year's best as shown on the second page, and progressive scores for use at the end of the competition year.
