Peter Pekaar hurt his back upon arrival and gingerly attempted his casts, albeit from an angle. Therefore, bending and walking generally were not an option for him. Felicity and Marcia managed to score for the men in the Accuracy events, and did a fine job, thanks for your help.

Chris Stickells deserves a special mention for putting out the flags today. In fact the whole day ran very smoothly due to general co-operation. Chris has improved a lot since his first dry casting day, midway through 2011. Now all of his distance casts are in court in the 50 metre plus range and his Accuracy is improving such that he scores on at least half of his casts. As he was casting with less than the required amount of line on his reel, this chopped into his distances. With his reel now correctly set up, we look forward to watching further improvements from Chris. Well done for persisting with dry casting.

Top double handed accuracy score went to Mark Hansen with 103 points, followed by Jeff Hewton with 85 points. Whilst the single handed accuracy went to Greg Keet with 18 points, second place went to three casters, each with 15 points (see score sheet in Reel Talk).

Marcia Pekaar and Felicity Keet cast together and whilst they were in separate divisions, Felicity scored 68 points in double handed accuracy compared to Marcia's less than exceptional 44 points. Well done Felicity, you are definitely the future for the SCAC Ladies' team. Felicity is very consistent, with all her casts being straight down the middle.

Our three Mini-Juniors had a good battle, with Shane Becu winning the double handed accuracy on 50 points. Morgan Keet won all the distance events whilst Olivia Keet and Shane

Becu can be proud that all their casts were in court. Let's hope these three can work together as a team at the AAA State Dry Cast in October this year.

Dry Casting results, 8 January 2012

These results have been prepared from the original hand written distances and scores recorded on the day. Marcia and Peter Pekaar copied the scores from the score sheets into an electronic format, adjusted the distance scores for the 20 metre measurement setback, and cross checked all final figures against the original score sheets. Terry Fuller used his computer drycasting scoring program to process the results to calculate the points, add all together, sort into final score order, extract the section winners and year's best as shown on the second page, and progressive scores for use at the end of the competition year.
