Initially the day started off with perfectly still conditions, but by the time casting commenced a moderate left to right cross court wind had set in, and by the end of the morning it had swung around to be a head wind.

Well done to the mini juniors, with each of them winning an event. Morgan winning the distance casting, Olivia winning the double handed accuracy and Owen winning the single handed accuracy, including a bullseye. Overall, the scores for them were very close in every event.

In the veterans double handed accuracy Allan Jones was a close winner over Terry Fuller, within striking distance in third place was Mal Head. Rob Pekaar was a clear winner for the second month in a row in the seniors section.

The single handed accuracy event featured 4 bullseyes, on each to Alan Hale, Allan Jones, Klaus Schonwolf and Owen Williams, as previously stated.

Peter Pekaar was the top single handed accuracy scorer on a day in a close duel with Terry Fuller and only a couple of points separating them in the end.

Gary Parkinson joined in the competition for the first time, learning tips from the other casters, but suffered at the hands of a series of out of court casts.

Greg Keet was limited to only casting single handed accuracy event, due to his sore back being in a brace, put his hand up to help out with scoring etc with the seniors and mini juniors.

Congratulations go to Terry Fuller for being the day's overall winner with 243 points, by one point over Alan Jones.

These scores include points for attendance at the July General Meeting. These results have been prepared from the original hand written distances and scores recorded on the day. Robert and Peter Pekaar copied the scores from the score sheets into an electronic format, adjusted the distance scores for the 20 metre measurement setback, and cross checked all final figures against the original score sheets. Terry Fuller used his computer drycasting scoring program to process the results to calculate the points, add all together, sort into final score order, extract the section winners and year's best, and the progressive scores for use at the end of the competition year.
