A light fog covering the oval greeted Andrew and myself as we turned into Wordsworth Avenue for the start of a new casting year. No sooner had we started setting up, other members arrived to offer assistance. First AJ and Rhys Jones, followed by Mal Head, Jimmy Strong and George Holman. Being my first day on the job, I was grateful for their help as I didn't really know what to do and by the time Terry Willison arrived, I began to appreciate the amount of work required beforehand to enable us to have a well run and competitive morning's casting. A sincere thank you goes to all those who helped out.

Starting later than usual, approximately 9am, we had 23 casters ready to go, including Terry Willison (back at the club after a two-year absence) and also new faces to casting, Greg & Holly Walker and visitor, Jody Pallet.

With a strong southerly blowing across the oval, some seniors had problems with double handed accuracy, but with the AAA size courts the ladies and veterans managed to score well, as noted by Mal Head, "It was good to see most people getting scores on the board".

Dean Stewart's 129 points in double handed accuracy was impressive as was John Crompton's 123 points. John has shown steady improvement in recent times and is definitely closing in on some of our seasoned Vets. Vix Alexander scored well with 150 points, but it appears she now actually has some competition in Wendy, Marcia and Jody.

Our visitor, Jody Pallet, was impressive. Distance and double handed accuracy were no problem, and when it came to single handed accuracy, she took six paces back so as not to over-cast the mark with a borrowed rod. Not bad at all! Marcia's excitement with her first bull's eye was short-lived when it became apparent that she had hit the centre of target two when in fact she was aiming for the THIRD target.

In single handed accuracy, Kaitlin Stoeckel scored with every cast, Ric Parker and Terry Fuller both scored bull's eyes, but Terry's score of 30 points won that section for the day.

Both Terry Willison and young Rhys Jones put in solid performances, considering both have been absent for a period.

Greg and Holly Walker were able to get some good scores, but the stand out was Mal Harris's 150m in the 56g event. Young Andrew's lack of sleep from the night before prevented him from reaching his full potential on the day.

Thank you to all who attended the first dry casting day of the season, and to Peter Stoeckel with the sausage sizzle and drinks.

Finally, a big thank you must go to Jimmy Strong who, despite not casting that day, came down to the oval early specifically to help out and ensure the day ran smoothly. Such displays of generosity and selflessness are to be commended.

Field Day Report

Rottneest 12-13 May

Seven members made the ferry trip over to the island Friday night in slightly bumpy seas which was an indication of weekend conditions to come. Saturday morning had a few clouds skidding around with the aid of a south easterly breeze. It had rained overnight but most of it had passed through by morning. As we rounded the last corner and drove along the top of the hill towards Radar, the reef did look fishable but knew we would have to get well and truly wet in the process. We all elected to fish the southern side of the island; Ian Taggart, Tino, Vix and myself fished Wilson's and Mark, Morris and Ian Cook fished just west of the Tailor hole. Ian T was into a Tailor after the first couple of casts and I dropped one soon after but that was the last we saw of them there. Ian did bag another Tailor further on from there later in the morning but those two were the only ones caught for the weekend. Herring were in plague proportions and made short work of any bait, it was hard to get anything past them. We all persisted around that area and by lunchtime, Tino was the most successful with two good size Salmon.

Meanwhile, Mark, Morris and Ian C were all into the Salmon up towards Radar with Mark landing two and Morris and Ian landing one each.

After lunch Mark, Morris, Ian C and I walked over to Cathedrals for perhaps the last time, as this section will be part of the new sanctuary zone which will be closed to fishing in the near future. The Herring were also in attendance here along with swarms of Wrasse, so a bait lasted no time at all. I got tired of the Herring and waded out to the rocks and had a Salmon in the bag the second cast which promised a hot session but an hour or so later it was still the only fish in the bag.

The wind had picked up in the afternoon and swung around to the usual south west and with it came an increase in the swell. The late afternoon session Mark, Ian C and I fished Radar but only just, a little more swell and it would not have been a safe option.

It was made a little more reassuring with the knowledge that we had all purchased buoyancy vests the week prior and wearing them over our jackets did not interfere with our fishing at all.

This is usually Yellowtail Kingfish time and we didn't have to wait that long before Ian's rod loaded up with a good fish but the inevitable happened when the fish found the safety of the underwater ledges. It looked good while it lasted, rod bent over double and Ian hanging on for dear life. I managed the only fish for that session, a good size Salmon that I had to chase around on top of the reef for a time before I eventually got him in the bag.

Tino and Ian T had stayed on at Wilson's for the afternoon and Tino was rewarded with his third Salmon for the day.

Sunday morning was a little different, grey, overcast and drizzling rain. Maybe that's why Vix, Tino and I were the only bodies on the bus, the others still tucked up in their warm beds.

We fished Wilson's again and it wasn't too long before Tino was into another Salmon. Vix got stitched up a couple of times with what were possibly Yellowtails which ran hard into the ledges and ended the struggle with a decisive snap. A little while later a Yellowtail made short work of Tino and only a few minutes later he had yet another one right to the reef in front of me but the fish was always in control and won the contest with ease.

Mark's Salmon weighed in at just over 4kg and earned him the heaviest scale fish for the trip and Tino won the day with his bag of 4 Salmon, congratulations to both.

The Rottnest trips are always good, especially now that we travel over on the Friday night which gives us two morning sessions (for those who can get out of their warm beds that is). Everybody caught fish; there was the odd glass of red consumed and good company enjoyed.

The next Rottnest trip is in August so put it in your calendar if you are after a good trip, it gets a little colder at that time of the years but it is still a buzz.

Our next field day is the long weekend at the start of June, this time to Emu Springs. This spot is on private land to which Ian C is able to arrange access for the club. The camping is great, lots of peppercorn trees; it's easily accessible by two wheel drive (although you do need a four wheel drive to get to the beach). Contact Cookie for location details.

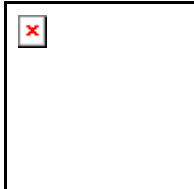
