#### **Dry Casting report 7 October 2012**

We would like to thank all the members who come down early to help set up for the day's casting, especially Ron Thomas. Since joining the club, he is always there very early and most things are in place before the rest of us get there. Ron's energy toward dry casting is outstanding, and appreciated by all.

Eddie Korin was a SCAC Member in the mid-1980s and has now rejoined with his wife, Debbie, and they both cast with us on Sunday, as well as Jane Keet. Up until then Jane had been an enthusiastic supporter of her husband and children, and has done a lot of scoring and scribing for the Club. Visitors for the day included Filomena and Tony D'Alonzo, Mick Burgin, and Wilf Core. It was nice to see Chris Stickells back at casting after a brief break.

Whilst the day was pleasant, unfortunately we had to contend with a strong wind blowing from left to right across the court, which had a negative impact on the distances. However, if you were lucky enough to have been casting when the wind did turn around onto our backs for a brief period, you would have reaped the benefits and in some cases members were casting their 56 gram weights further than their 112 gram weights, to which both Peter Osborne and Dean Stewart can attest.

Our Club has produced another Champion with Morgan Keet not only breaking a mini junior Club record but also a mini junior State record in double handed accuracy with a score of 85 points out of a possible 100. This record was previously held by another SCAC member, Owen Williams. Along with Olivia Keet, these younger members are the future of all Clubs.

Top double handed accuracy score went to Terry Fuller with 163 points. Mal Head started well, scoring 82 points with his first four casts, unfortunately he went off the boil after that. Had Trevor Stam not been let down by a couple of casts, his double handed accuracy score would have been right up there. Having recently returned from hip surgery and nearly cutting off two fingers of his casting hand with a bench saw, Allan Jones won the single handed accuracy with 31 points, and was the only member to score a bullseye on the day.

Shane Wignell would have been pleased with his efforts, having personal bests in both the artificial bait and 112 gram events. The tussle continues between George Holman and Ron Thomas for the longest Veterans cast. While George won the 56 gram and the artificial bait, Ron took out the 112 gram event.

Well done to Terry Fuller for having the day's top score with 272 points.

Many thanks also go to Pat McKeown and Andy Thorgersen for organising the barbeque, and to Terry Fuller who does so much work for the club as well as collecting the day's takings.

I would also like to thank my wife, Marcia, as she assisted me greatly with editing and typing all my reports over the years with this great club.
