A.A.A. OF W.A. REPORT:

The March meeting of the above saw a pretty warm welcome for our delegate from the President of the Association due to a comment by our Club President in the last month's issue of "Reel Talk". He seems to take too many things too personal.

On the financial side the Associations funds stand at a total of \$7685.

Our club motion re a minimum of 15 financial members to be maintained to the Association otherwise the club loses voting rights etc until the 15 financial members is reached again was ruled invalid and has to be re-put in a more formal manner.

A lot of clubs are still unfinancial to the Association and are to be sent accounts.

Agnew Clough has made an approach to the Association for us to put signs up at Steep Point to show anglers a hole they have dug so anglers can place all their rubbish in instead of leaving it strewn around the camping areas.

Cost of banners for State events is creeping up. They cost \$4.50 each. It was pointed out that the Estuary banners will cost \$200 approx.

A request was made for clubs to put their names and a phone number to be contacted on in the yellow pages.

The Steering Committee for the 1985 Australian Championships has selected the last three weeks of March as the time and the venue will be selected from Albany Bunbury Mandurah and Geraldton.
